A financial report was provided for the August period of operations and budget line item comparisons for the year were noted by the Administrative Treasurer.

There was no public input, so Chairman continued to the next agenda item.

Superintendent presented an Aqua Pards program financial analysis for the past 6 months in 2018. He noted that this year is the best on record. Board made comments. It was noted that the program committee will meet on determining entry rates for 2019 (potentially on 10-8-18 prior to meeting). Superintendent also stated that the board meeting in November will be held on Nov. 12th.

Mary Smith of the West Livingston Advisory Committee reported that a committee member passed away in the past month. She noted that future renovation on the mens and ladies restrooms will need budget consideration in the future. Superintendent shared the various painting projects planned for soon.

David Henderson, Maintenance, noted that the track renovation low quote totaled \$20,124 from R.J.Daigle Paving. This project should begin in 2 weeks. He stated that the soccer field construction is ongoing with addition of sand and drainage adjustments made.

John Arbor, Director, stated that registration for flag football is almost complete. He stated that the soccer season registration gross collection was at an all time high. He noted that East Side Elementary has decided to limit the number of children transported to the Park each afternoon and this may impact the gross collections of after care in the last four months of 2018.

Sandy McGrew, stated that all fitness programs are running smoothly.

Rod Vulgamore noted that repairs to the new pet area (South Park) have been made inclusive of the fence installation.
